## COCO PALMS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING MARCH 25, 2024

## A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Armando Silva called the March 25, 2024, Regular Board Meeting of the Coco Palms Community Development District (the "District") to order at 6:35 p.m. in the Artesa Clubhouse located at 11690 SW 248<sup>th</sup> Street, Homestead, Florida 33032.

## **B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION**

Armando Silva presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on October 23, 2023, as legally required.

## C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Armando Silva determined that the attendance of the following Board Members constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting: Chairperson Corissa Nguyen, Vice Chairperson Seth Patterson and Supervisors Charles Handal and Nilka Gomez.

Staff in attendance included: District Manager Armando Silva of Special District Services, Inc.; District Counsel Gregory George of Billing, Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey, P.A..

## D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.

## E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

## F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

## 1. October 12, 2023, Special Board Meeting

Mr. Silva presented the October 12, 2023, Special Board Meeting minutes and asked if there were any comments and/or changes. There being no comments or changes, a **motion** was made by Mr. Handal, seconded by Ms. Gomez and unanimously passed approving the October 12, 2023, Special Board Meeting minutes, *as presented*.

## G. OLD BUSINESS 1. Staff Report, as Required

There was no staff report at this time.

## H. NEW BUSINESS

## 1. Consider Resolution No. 2024-01 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Proposed Budget

Mr. Silva presented Resolution No. 2024-01, entitled:

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-01**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COCO PALMS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT APPROVING A PROPOSED BUDGET AND NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024/2025 AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Silva provided an explanation for the document and explained that the proposed 2024/2025 fiscal year budget would be balanced by designating a carryover of approximately \$22,200 from the projected fund balance as of September 30, 2023. Mr. Silva advised that since the overall proposed assessments were not increasing in the fiscal year 2024/2025, letters to the residents would not be required. Furthermore, Mr. Silva stated as part of Resolution No. 2024-01, the Board must set a date for the public hearing to adopt the fiscal year 2024/2025 final budget and assessment roll. A discussion ensued after which:

A **motion** was made by Ms. Gomez, seconded by Ms. Nguyen and unanimously passed to approve and adopt Resolution No. 2024-01, *as presented*, setting the public hearing to adopt the fiscal year 2024/2025 final budget and assessments for June 24, 2024, at 6:30 p.m. in the Artesa Clubhouse located at 11690 SW 248<sup>th</sup> Street, Homestead, Florida 33032; and further authorizes publication/notice of the budget public hearing, as required by law.

## 2. Discussion Regarding Ethics Training

Mr. Silva presented a memorandum from SDS, Inc. which will serve as a reminder that beginning January 1, 2024, elected and appointed commissioners of community redevelopment agencies and local officers of independent special districts are required to complete four (4) hours of ethics training annually. The training must address, at a minimum, s. 8, Art. II of the Florida Constitution (ethics for public officers and financial disclosure), the Code of Ethics for Public Officers and Employees, and the Florida Public Records Law and Open Meetings laws.

## 3. Discussion Regarding Expansion of Lanes on 248<sup>th</sup> Street and 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue

Mr. Handal stated that he would like an update regarding the expansion of roads located along SW 248th Street and SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Mr. Silva stated that the aforementioned roads are outside of the District boundaries and he would have District Field Operations Staff contact the Miami-Dade County Department of Transportation for an update.

# 4. Discussion Regarding Adding Turnpike Sound Wall and Street Lights on 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue

Mr. Handal asked if it was possible to add a sound barrier wall along the southern portion of the District bordering the Turnpike. Mr. Silva stated that the sound barrier wall request is usually made by Florida Department of Transportation and he would have District Field Operations Staff contact the Florida Department of Transportation for an update.

## L. ADMINISTRATIVE & OPERATIONAL MATTERS

Mr. Silva advised the Board that the two (2) seats whose terms are expiring in November 2024 are Seat #1 (Monica Encinas) and Seat #2 (Charles Handal). Mr. Silva further explained that the qualifying period to run for the District election on the general election ballot would be from noon on June 10, 2024, through noon on June 14, 2024.

## M. BOARD MEMBER & STAFF CLOSING COMMENTS

There were no board member or staff closing comments.

## N. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, a **motion** was made by Mr. Patterson, seconded by Mr. Handal and passed unanimously to adjourn the Regular Board Meeting at approximately 7:06 p.m.
